Every time you read the Bible, God speaks!

God wants you to know who He is, what He has done and how much He loves you. God wants you to love Him and because you love Him, to live like He lives. God uses His Bible to help you in all these ways.

This summer as you read the Bible, God invites you to listen to Him and to grow to know, love and follow Him more! Here are some things you can do to help you hear what God wants to tell you:

#1 Choose a time and place to meet with God.

- Meet at a time when you can pay attention and give God your best.
- Go to a quiet place where you won't be disturbed or distracted by things or people.

#2 Pray!

- Ask God to help you hear and understand what He wants to tell you.
- Ask Him to help you love Him more.
- Ask Him to show you how to follow Him better.

#3 Read the Bible verses for the day.

#4 Use your journal to think about, write down and remember what God has told you.

#5 Pray!

- Thank God for meeting with you.
- Ask Him to help you live what He has shown you.

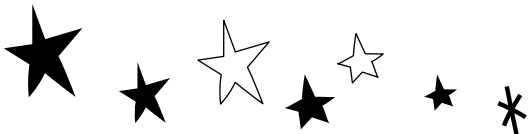

1. Draw or write about 2 things God does in these verses.

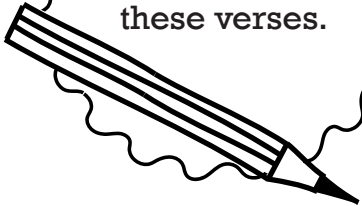




2. How can you know, love and or follow God better? Draw or write about how you might do this.



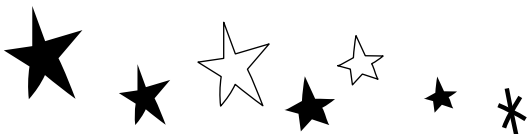
WEEK 2 • DAY 2

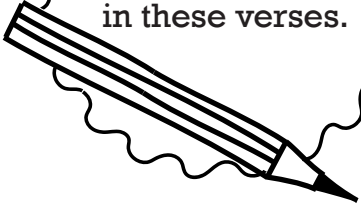

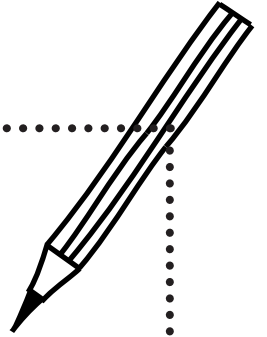

2. Draw or write a prayer thanking God.

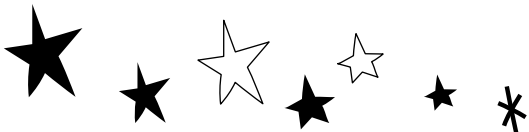
WEEK 4 • DAY 4

2. What do you have, or what can you do, that you can give or do for God?

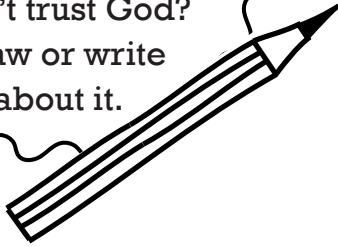

Draw or write about it.



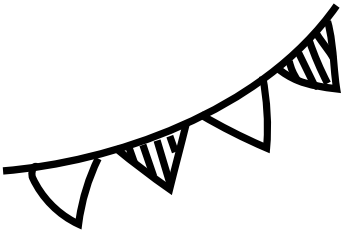
2. What are you doing, thinking or saying that shows you are not trusting God? How can you live differently? Draw or write it and tell God about it.

2. How has God taught you to live? Are you living that way...all the time with a happy heart? Draw or write about it here, then ask God to help you live in the way He has taught you.



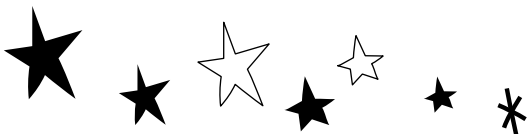

1. Draw a picture of what is happening in these verses.

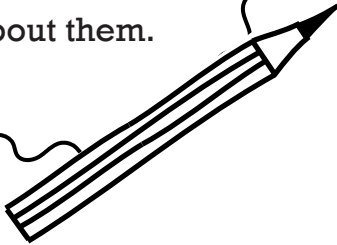

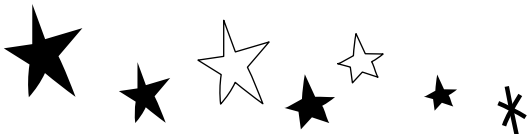
WEEK 7 • DAY 1

2. What would you like God to do for you or someone you know? Draw or write about it then ask Him.





Draw or write about it here.

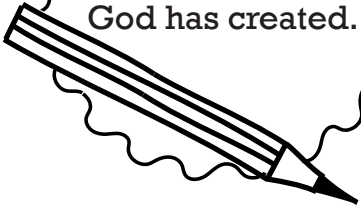


Today's Bible Reading:
