Read the Bible verses for the day.


Use your journal to think about, write down and remember what God has told you.

2. Solomon was glad God came to live in the temple he built for God. Draw or write a prayer thanking God for something wonderful He has done for you.



Draw or write a prayer to God asking for His forgiveness.



2. How does knowing God like this help you...help you to live differently?


2 Kings 8:1-6

Isaiah 2:1-5


1. Draw or write about what God will do for His people according to these verses.

2. What from these verses do you need to remember about Jesus? Draw or write about it.


Isaiah 12:1-3

1. What does God do for His people, Israel?





1. How do these verses point you to Jesus?



Isaiah 49:6-7


1. How do these verses point you to Jesus?
