NOVEMBER 1

**Psalm 92, 2 Kings 1,
Zechariah 5, James 4:11-5:12**

Psalm 92:1-2 “It is good to give thanks to the Lord, to sing praises to your name, O Most High; to declare your steadfast love in the morning, and your faithfulness by night.”

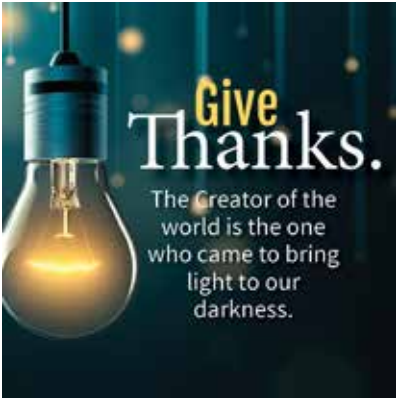


NOVEMBER 2

Then he prayed again, and heaven gave rain, and the earth bore its fruit.”

Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving; let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise! For the Lord is a great God, and a great King above all gods. In his hand are the depths of the earth; the heights of the mountains are his also. The sea is his,

for he made it, and his hands formed the dry land. Oh come, let us worship and bow down; let us kneel before the Lord, our Maker!"

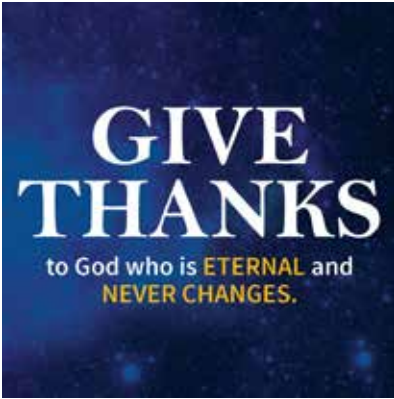


NOVEMBER 10

He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities. For as high as the heavens are above the earth, so great is his steadfast love toward those who fear him; as far as the east is from the west, so far does he remove our transgressions from us."

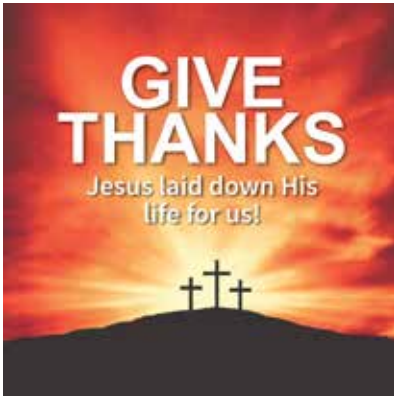


NOVEMBER 15

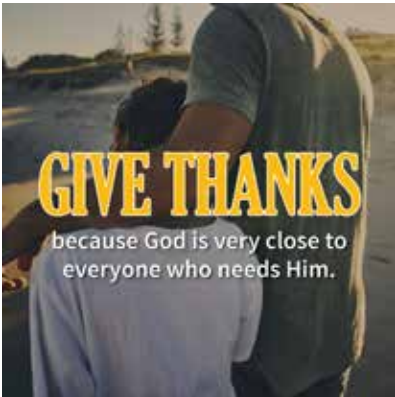


NOVEMBER 17

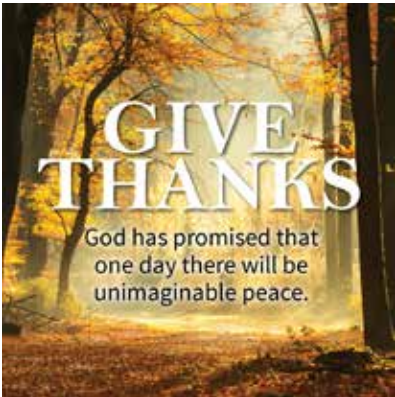

Job 1:20 "Naked I came from my mother's womb, and naked shall I return. The Lord gave, and the Lord has taken away; blessed be the name of the Lord."

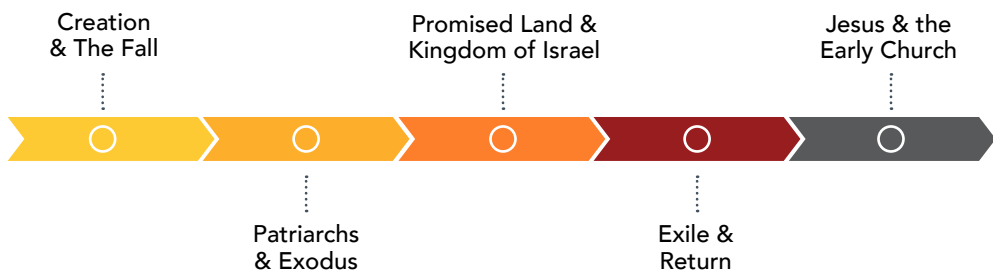

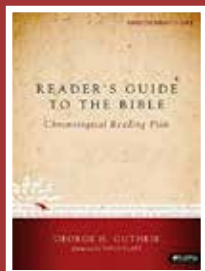
COMING TO THE OAK IN 2020
