“What Will Be Your Legacy?”

2 Peter 1:12-15

1. The reminders of “these” qualities (1:12)
2. The need for “this” reminder now, not later (1:13-14)

3. The making of the memory of “these” things after you are gone (1:15)

Table Talk

- 1) For whom do you want to leave a legacy? What kind of legacy do you want to leave behind? Who left a legacy for you? What did they leave you?
- 2) What are the qualities that Peter wants to remind his readers? Why should we be repetitive? If a person understands, knows, and is established in some truth, why repeat it? (v. 12)
- 3) When should a person work on their legacy? Why is it too late to leave a purposeful legacy after you are dead? (vv. 13-14)
- 4) What does Peter give as the reason that he is so intent on making every effort to impart truth to his readers while he is alive? (v. 15)
