- 5) Describe the attributes of God in verses 15-16. Why does Paul appeal to God's attributes as the basis and goal of our living holy lives?
- 6) Which would you rather be—rich in the present age or rich in the one to come? How can we who are rich in the present age invest our treasure for a good foundation for the future? What "future" is Paul talking about? (vv. 17-19)
- 7) What about Paul's last instructions in this letter impress you? How can you avoid "irreverent babble" and focus on what really matters? (vv. 20-21)
