- 4) Are you being built up in your faith? In what ways? How does God describe growth occurring in His children? What is God doing in your life to grow you? What role does His Word play in that process?
- 5) What does it mean to pray in the Spirit? What does it reveal if we are not faithful in prayer? How do we grow in our ability to pray?
- 6) What does it look like to be "waiting for the mercy of the Lord Jesus Christ"?
- 7) How can God grow churches in our area in unity with one another? What is the basis for our unity? What are the barriers to unity?
