Table Talk

- 1) What are the five virtues described in verse 12? How do they contrast with the vices described in verse 5?
- 2) Where is the practice of godly character best revealed? What does it mean to “bear with one another”? Give an example. What are some things that make forgiveness complicated? How does Paul simplify it in verse 13?
- 3) What keeps the peace of Christ from ruling your heart? (v. 15) How does the nature of Christian community make the rule of Christ easier?
- 4) What parts of corporate worship does Paul emphasize in verse 16? Why is an individualistic view of worship something that will distract us from real worship? How does the corporate view of worship affect one’s view of church music? Why should we be glad when music styles that are not our personal preference come to our church?
- 5) What does it mean to do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God? What is something that you are facing that you need to surrender to this principle?
