- 3) How does Sarai's plan "work"? How does it go wrong? Whom does Sarai blame for the problems? Why is it hard to face ourselves when our plans go against God's? Have you ever blamed your spouse or God for things that go wrong? Why do we second-guess God?
- 4) What are the negative results of Sarai's plan? How are we affected today by Sarai's plan?
- 5) How does God show Hagar His grace? Why would God bless and multiply the offspring of Hagar?
- 6) How does impatience keep you from being an effective Christian? What delays are you experiencing in your life where you need to keep trusting God and to be careful not to sin by your own scheming?
