2. How does God make Himself known to Abram? (vv. 1-2) What kinds of promises does God make? (vv. 3-8) How do these verses bring encouragement to every follower of the true God?
3. What is the importance of changing Abram and Sarai's names? How does God's call to Abraham to obedient response challenge us? (vv. 9-14)
4. In what ways does God extend His grace to Sarah and to Ishmael? (vv. 15-22) What does this say about the nature of God's grace? How are you experiencing God's grace right now?
5. How does Abraham respond to this revelation of God's covenant? (vv. 23-27) How should we respond to God's revelation of His covenant with us?
