- 1) What are some of the blessings of old age? How do you see the blessing of God on Abraham's life?
- 2) What three concerns does Abraham present to his servant (see vv. 3, 4, and 6)? How is Abraham's statement in verse 8 like the three Hebrews in the fiery furnace (Daniel 3:18)? What are some things that you hold true despite the "but ifs"?
- 3) What do you think of Abraham remarrying? How might the birth of six children change him in his old age (25:1-4)?
- 4) What provision did Abraham make for his second family? What provision did he make for Isaac (25:5-6)? Is that fair? What challenges do blended families bring in our own day?
- 5) How is Abraham described in death (25:7-8)? Who buries him? Where is he buried? Why are those matters important (25:9-10)?
- 6) What is significant about Isaac's moving down to Beer-lahai-roi? How might that be good? How might that be potentially troublesome?
- 7) What do you make of the statement: "God's people will die; God's promises will not die"?
